On foot: It takes 20 minutes from Okayama Univ. to the Recent Culture Hotel.

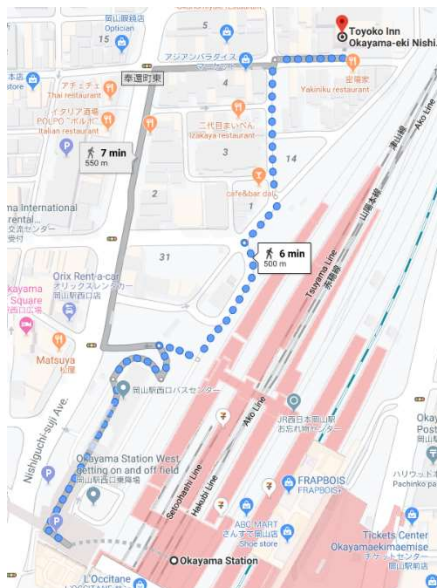
